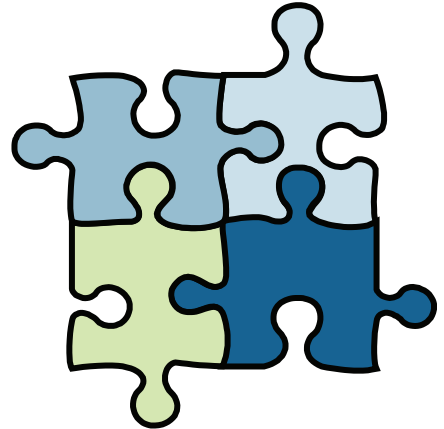


# Let TAP help you put the pieces together!
